In a fraught and tense world, with multiple challenges for life and ministry, finding sanctuary in God is more important than ever for Christian students and those who serve them. IFES movements around the world are dealing with political and economic instability, campus access difficulties and mental health crises (to name but a few), yet continue sharing the hope of Christ, and are able to testify that God is with them no matter how calm or stormy the sea.

On 18 October, IFES World Student Day 2024, more than 34,600 people in 140 countries and territories were praying for students and exalting God's name in all the earth. Praise God for the way in which groups used the event to connect - with God, with others on

their own campus (like at UNPRG in Peru, above), with other groups locally or elsewhere in their movement and region, and with friends and peers around the world online. Feedback after the event showed how appreciated the five-day devotional guide and the prayer cards were, giving prayers a specific focus, and giving readers insight into Christian student and graduate ministry in very different contexts. SERVING TOGETHER IN NATIONAL MOVEMENTS

"We can feel overwhelmed when processing various issues at our board meetings. The final say, however, should belong not to us, but to the Bible. We constantly need to examine our governance culture and practice in the light of Scripture. It should always be the ultimate reference in any policy we create and any decision we make as a board."

So wrote long term IFES staff Mirek Pieszka, most recently the Director of the IFES Governance Development program in 'Good and Faithful', a devotional book he compiled for those serving on national movement boards. Mirek has recently retired from this role (meet his successor below), but the team he built up and the training materials they have developed are a huge resource for IFES national movements and their board members.

Why focus on boards? Because student generations last only a few years and staff cohorts need to be supported and equipped to serve them. Without good training and smooth leadership transitions, previously strong student groups can disappear and staff burn out and move on quickly if not invested in and provided with the skills and care they need. Boards serving according to biblical principles and empowered with key governance skills provide the solid foundations needed for thriving ministry.

Praise God for Mirek and the 34 IFES Governance Development trainers across our fellowship, running online and in person training for new and experienced board members, mentoring and coaching individuals and being a listening ear and source of wise counsel for those in times of crisis.
